Dear chairman and members of verification commission,
dear ms. Metzeler,

During the congress in bled 2002 i was being not aware about that the exemption of registration fee for women's tournaments is to be discussed and it is to be deleted from the financial regulations. i would have voted against. but some how it has been passed.

But i'm concerned about using of this regulation. this year national championships were held, men's championship was category 1 rr and women's category 4w rr with 6 rated players only (!), respectively. and now the FIDE invoice shows that we have to pay CHF50 (category 1) for men's c-ship and CHF100 (!) for women's championship as per category 4 tournament. but i think this is too unfair.

Hence the fide tournament category 1 starts with 9w for women's tournaments, our women's national championship (category 4w) must be considered as category 0 tournament. So it must be waived from registration fee or charged as minimum as category 1 fee. otherwise, we will no more send women's national championship results to fide to register. We are not able to spend chf100 for our 6 fide rated lady players.

I hope you consider this matter positively.
