As to the agenda of FIDE meeting, I propose the following items to be included in the QC agenda:

- Report of Titles&Ratings Committee
- Report of Arbiters' Council
- World Ranking of federations and players (Short description: For example, in football the countries/federations are ranked based on certain facts, in tennis, the players are ranked annually based on the results in the tournaments, similar systems could be created for chess, too. QC Chairman brings his own proposals to the meeting)
- Other matters

I do not know whether there is an agenda from Mr. O'Connell for Titles and Ratings Committee, but I would like to have the following items:

Clarification of title and rating rules

- status of national team championships (with too few foreigners) between Istanbul and 1.7.2003
- multiple round-robins to be clarified
- objections against titles (aka Krasenkov's letter)
- extra point(s) and extra game(s)
- missing game in a norm when the opponent does not show up Open titles
- A list of open titles will be discussed, some of them are related to the issues above

Lowering the rating floor to 1600, schedule and actions

Going to individual expected results (Anand's proposal)

Including opponents names and results against each opponent in the rating history
