ANNEX FIDE COUNCIL DECISION

The FIDE Council has approved the decision of holding the FIDE General Assembly online, on December 17, 2023 (Sunday).

According to the FIDE Charter, the Assembly, together with the meetings of the Zonal Council, the FIDE Council, and the Commissions, forms the FIDE Congress, which dates are as follows:

- FIDE Commissions meetings: December 11-13, 2023.
- FIDE Council meeting: December 14, 2023.
- FIDE Zonal Council meeting: December 16, 2023
- FIDE General Assembly: December 17, 2023.

The exact time of the meetings, agenda, hosting platform, and invitation link will be provided in future communication.

If your National Federation or Affiliated Organization would like to propose an item to be included in the online General Assembly agenda, please provide the FIDE Office with all the necessary documents, using the email office@fide.com. According to the FIDE Charter, these proposals should reach the FIDE offices at least two months before the opening date of the General Assembly, so please make sure to send them by October 17, 2023.

We would also like to draw your attention to the provisions of Article 17.6 of the FIDE Charter and the requirements for delegates. Regarding the Commissions meetings, the meeting of a Commission may be held at an earlier date than the one proposed here, taking into account the opinion of the Commission members.
