



1st FIDE Confederation Cup for the disabled people 2019

8-14 December, 2019

Ankara, Turkey

1. INVITATION

1.1. The 1st FIDE Confederation Cup for the disabled people 2019 is an invitational championship between mixed teams from 4 continents, with the participation of chess players from three groups of disabilities (visually impaired, hearing impaired and physically disabled). The Cup is organized as a premier chess competition on the eve of the 1st World Chess Paralympics 2020.

1.2. Turkish Chess Federation on behalf of FIDE invites players to participate in the 1st FIDE Confederation Cup for the disabled people 2019 which will take place from 8th December (arrival) to 14th December (departure) 2019 in Ankara, Turkey.

2. PARTICIPATION

2.1. Teams from 4 Chess Continents will consist of 6 chess players. Chess players of three groups of disabilities will be presented in each mixed team: visually impaired, hearing impaired and physically disabled. Every team should consist of at least a woman player and at least one physically disabled player. In case of force majeure situations, maximum 3 local players can be added to each continental team.

2.2. In addition, the fifth team will be set as a sponsor team – “Russia-Turkey team”, which consists of 3 players from the hosting federation and 3 players from the country of a sponsor (Russia). The sponsor team should consist of at least a woman player and at least one physically disabled player.

2.3. Each invited participant doesn't bear any travel or accommodation expenses to take part in the Cup. In case of necessity, the organizing committee will consider the expenses coverage of accompanying persons (ie approved accompanying persons) as well.

2.4. All other accompanying persons (doctors, federations' officials, etc) shall cover their travel as well as accommodation expenses themselves.

3. PLAYING CONDITIONS & SCHEDULE

3.1. The tournament shall be conducted as a Team Round Robin competition of 5 rounds and will be played according to the FIDE regulations.

3.2. Time Control: 90 min. with an increment of 30 seconds per move/from move one. The default period is 15 minutes.

Changes in the schedule might be made by organizers, if necessary, after consultation with FIDE. Attendance is required at the opening and closing ceremonies.

4. REGISTRATION

4.1. Registration deadline is 20th November 2019.

4.2. Registration form should be submitted before 20th November 2019. A digital ID photo and a clear scanned Passport Copy and medical certificate of each player should be sent by email to the Organizing Committee. Accompanying persons should provide a digital photo and a clear scanned Passport copy.

5. ACCOMMODATION & LOCAL TRAVEL

5.1. Playing venue and official hotel is The Green Park Hotel Ankara 5*.

5.2. All invited players and approved accompanying persons will be provided with lodging from afternoon of 8th December till noon of 14th December 2019. The invited players and approved accompanying persons will be accommodated in double shared bedrooms on FB bases.

5.3. Any additional accompanying persons and/or federations' officials will be accommodated upon their request and in a requested room type for their own expenses.

Single room with three meals: 450 USD for 6 nights
Double room with three meals: 525 USD for 6 nights.

5.4. The check-in time is after 14:00 and check-out time is before 12:00 noon.

5.5. Turkish chess federation is responsible for free transportation from and to Ankara international airport to the official hotel.

6. PRIZES AND TROPHIES

6.1. The cups and medals will be given to the teams finished 1, 2 and 3rd.

6.2. The Cups will be given to the chess players in each disabled group section for the highest score gained during the Cup. Medals for the 2nd and 3rd place in each disabled group and section will be presented.

6.3. Certificates of participation will be given to all chess players.

7. CHIEF ARBITER, FIDE TECHNICAL DELEGATE AND APPEALS PROCEDURES

7.1. The Chief Arbiter and his assistants will be appointed by the Organizing Committee in consultation with FIDE.

7.2. FIDE Technical Delegate is appointed by FIDE – Mrs. Kema Goryaeva.

7.2. Appeals procedures will be provided according to the FIDE regulations.

8. RANKING

8.1 The team which scores more board points in a match than its opponents, receives two match points. The losing team receives no match points. In the case a match ends with equal sum of the board points, each team receives one match point.



8.2. The ranking will be determined according to match points, the team obtaining the highest number of match points being declared the winner of the competition.

8.3. The order of teams that finish with the same number of match points shall be determined by application of the following tie-breaking procedures in sequence, proceeding from (a) to (b) to (c) to (d) the extent required:

- (a) By the number of board points won, the highest number wins;
- (b) by the sum of Sonneborn-Berger points, which is calculated as follows: match points of each opponent, excluding the opponent who scored the lowest number of match points, multiplied by the number of board points scored against each opponent respectively. The highest number wins;
- (c) By the sum of the board points of all team's opponents, the highest number wins;
- (d) By the sum of the board points of all opponents defeated plus one half of the board points of all the opponents with which a tied result was achieved, the highest number wins.

8.4. Individual prizes in team competitions: the highest score and if tie highest performance rating wins. In case of a tie it shall be broken by: (a) mutual results (if all played each other); (b) number of games, the highest number wins; (c) percentage score, the highest number wins, (d) final ranking of a team, the player in the highest ranked team wins.

9. VISAS

9.1. All players and accompanying persons who require a visa to enter Turkey must send a copy of passport (page with photo and key information) to the Organizer's email address to: umit.kucuk@tsf.org.tr (Umit Kucukahmetoglu) for the visa invitation before the deadline of 20th November 2019 after which the Organizer shall not be responsible. Please state your team and disability group.

10. COMMERCIAL ISSUES.

10.1. No proposed sponsor should be in conflict with the regulations of International Olympic Committee.

10.2. The FIDE logo is displayed in a black and white color on a white background. The text describing the event must not be larger than twice the size of the word FIDE reproduced in the logo.

10.3. The logo of the main sponsor and Turkish Chess Federation should be displayed in all banners, roll-ups and other products related to the championship in accordance with the sponsor's official logo requirements.
