Decision/Resolution “On Transfer Regulations”

Approved by the FIDE Council on: 20 September 2023

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FIDE Council has considered special conditions on admission to FIDE team events of those players (hereinafter – Transferred players) who have transferred to a new federation before 31 August 2023 in accordance with Council Resolution <https://fide.com/news/2247> (hereinafter – Resolution) as well as a number of questions related to the Transfer Regulations.

After deliberation and taking into consideration of the FIDE Council’s opinions in respect of the preferred options, FIDE Council has resolved:

- 1.To confirm that for all transfers of Ukrainian players that will take place in 2023-2024, FIDE waives the right to charge Transfer fee.
- 2.To extend the right to perform under the FIDE flag for Russian and Belorussian players who are currently playing under it till January1,2025.
- 3.To approve that every team may have up to 2 (two) Transferred players in FIDE team events.

After the general term restrictions expire, the player is allowed to participate in it without limitation and is not regarded as a Transferred player;

The new federation retains the right to pay the compensation fee for those players who cannot participate for free in order to allow them to play in team events immediately;

FIDE waves its Transfer fee in all cases when the compensation fee is paid to the old federation for the Transferred players.
