





# ZONE 4.4 YOUTH UNDER-16 TEAM CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019

5 December 2019 To 12 December 2019

Luke Hotel, Nairobi, Kenya.

Under the auspices of the African Chess Confederation (ACC), the Chess Kenya Federation has the honour of hosting the Zone 4.4 Youth Under-16 Team Chess Championships 2019.

#### 1. INVITATION

Under the auspices of the African Chess Confederation (ACC), the Chess Kenya Federation has the honor of inviting all Zone 4.4 African Federations affiliated to the World Chess Federation (FIDE) to participate in the Zone 4.4 Youth Under-16 Team Chess Championships 2019.

#### 2. VENUE AND DATES

The Zone 4.4 Youth Under-16 Team Chess Championships 2019 will be held from 5<sup>th</sup> **December (Arrival) to 12<sup>th</sup> December (Departure) 2019** at the **Luke Hotel, Nairobi, Kenya**. (https://thelukehotel.co.ke/) The Luke Hotel will serve as the Official Playing Venue and Accommodation for participants, officials and accompanying persons.

#### 3. PARTICIPATION CRITERIA AND ACCOMMODATION COSTS

Each Zone 4.4 member federation has the right to send up to 3 teams but only **One Team will** have **free board and lodging** from  $5^{th} - 12^{th}$  December.

Each team shall comprise 4 players and 1 reserve (at least two of them must be girls) and 1 captain (or Manager/Trainer).

In accordance with ACC regulations, entitled participating teams should comprise of players born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2003.

Additional teams may be accepted on application subject to a maximum of three Teams per federation. Additional teams will pay (US\$ 45) per person per day inclusive of all meals in shared rooms and (US\$50) per person per day in single rooms accommodation; inclusive of all meals.

The additional teams will be required to pay Registration and ACC Tournament Fees as stipulated in Clause 4.

Heads of Delegation, officials and accompanying persons from participating federations will be required to lodge at the **Luke Hotel**, and will be required to pay (**US\$ 45**) **per person per day** inclusive of all meals in shared rooms and (**US\$ 50**) **per person per day** in single rooms accommodation; inclusive of all meals.

#### 4. REGISTRATION FEES AND ACC TOURNANENT FEES

The Registration Fee of (US\$ 60) per person for the Official Team of 5 players and 1 Captain has been waived. Players will be required to pay the ACC Tournament Fee of (US\$ 50) per player.

The Additional Teams will be required to pay Registration Fee of (US\$ 60) per person and ACC Tournament Fees of (US\$ 50) per player.

Payments for Registration Fees and Accommodation Fees should be paid to the Chess Kenya Federation by **15**<sup>th</sup> **November 2019**. The account details of which are indicated at Article 5.

Payments for the ACC Tournament Fee should be paid into the account of the African Chess Confederation as indicated in Article 6.

#### 7. TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

The cost of traveling to Kenya and returning home again shall be the responsibility of each team or federation.

The Organizers will meet participants and accompanying persons at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) provided that full itinerary for each participant and their accompanying persons are communicated to the organizers not later than **18th November 2019**.

Transport from the terminals to the venue and back is provided free of charge by the organizers.

#### 8. TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND TIE BREAK

The Championships will be played in accordance with FIDE regulations on a 7 Round Swiss System basis. However, in the event that the number of participating teams is less than twelve, the tournament will be adjusted to a Round Robin (all-play-all) event.

The games will be played using DGT Digital chess clocks.

The rate of play will be in accordance with the FIDE rules: 90 minutes for the first 40 moves, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game, with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one. The final positions of the teams shall be established by the number of game points scored by each team.

When the Swiss System is used, the position of teams that finish with the same number of match points shall be determined by application of the following tiebreaking procedures, in sequence:

- a. By the game points;
- b. By the game scores of all the team's opponents;
- c. By the result of the matches between teams in contention.

When the Round Robin system is used, the following tie-breaking apply, in sequence:

- a. The game points;
- b. The match result between teams in question;
- c. The Sonnenborn-Berger points;

#### 9. PRIZES

- I. The Organizing Committee will award **Gold, Silver and Bronze medals** to the 6 members of the teams taking the first three places respectively.
- II. Certificates of participation will be awarded to all participating teams.

#### 10. TRAVEL GRANT TO 2020 WORLD YOUTH U-16 CHESS OLYMPIAD

The 6 members of the winning team will receive travel grants to the 2020 World Youth Under-16 Chess Olympiad.

#### 11. TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE
