AFRICAN JUNIOR U20 CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS, ALGIERS, ALGERIA

23th January to 1st February 2013 Hosted by the Bouaza Hotel Tiaret, Algeria

1. INVITATION

Under the auspices of the African Chess Confederation, The Algerian Chess Federation (FADE) has the honour of inviting African Federations affiliated to FIDE to participate in the 2013 African Junior U20 Open Chess Championship and African Junior U20 Girls' Chess Championship.

2. Venue and Dates

The 2013 African Junior U20 Chess Championships will be held from the 23th January 2013 (arrival) to 1st February 2013 (departure) at **hotel Bouaza in Tiaret** (300 km west of Algiers) Algeria.

3. Participants' Criteria and Accommodation Costs

- 3.1 In accordance with FIDE regulations, entitled participants are those players born on or after 1st January 1993.
- 3.2 The tournament will be played in two sections, namely « open » event and « girl » event. The Algerian Chess Federation will provide full board and lodging for two players, one boy and one girl, from each FIDE affiliated African National Federation.
- 3. 3 Additional players may be accepted on application subject to a maximum of 4 players per federation in each category.
- 3.4 The players and officials are required to stay at the playing venue.
- All fees should be paid into the FADE account by 22th December 2013 the account details of which are indicated below.
- 3.5 lodging for additional players and accompanying persons will cost:
 - a) In twin rooms: $\in 65.00$ per person per day for meals and accommodation
 - b) In single rooms: \in 80.00 per person per day for meals and accommodation

4. FIDE/ACU Fees

- 4.1 In accordance with FIDE regulations an entry fee of \in 70 (seventy Euros) is required for each invited or additional player.
- 4.2 Federations are responsible for paying the entry fees for each of their players. All fees should be paid into the FADE account by 22th December 2013 the account details of which are indicated below.

5. Registration

- 5.1 All players and accompanying persons must pay the Organizers an organization fee of 100 € when registering upon their arrival.
- 5.2 The deadline for registration is 22th December 2013
- 5.3 Players will not be paired until all the payments are effected to the organisers. After this date a penalty of C50.00 (fifty Euros) for each late registration will be charged to participants. However, organisers reserve the right to decline late registrations.

No participant shall be allowed to take part in the event without full payment of all fees.

6. Travel Arrangements

- 6.1The cost of travelling to Algiers and returning home again is for the personal account of the participants.
- 6.2The hosts shall meet the participants and accompanying persons at the Algiers International Airport, provided that full flight details, including arrival times, is completed in writing on the accompanying entry form, by no later than 23th September 2013.
- 6.3Transport from the Airport to the Hotel and back is included in the registration fee.

7. System and Rate of play

- 8.1 The championship format will be a Swiss System tournament played over 9 (nine rounds) in accordance with FIDE Regulations. However, should the number of participants be ten or less, the tournament can be adjusted to a Round Robin (all-play-all) event.
- 8.2 The games will be played using Digital chess clocks.
- 8.3 The rate of play will be in accordance with the FIDE rules: 90 minutes, with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one (Fisher System).

8. Tie-Break

In both events, if there is a tie for the medal winners will be resolved in the following order;

Swiss System

- a) By the results between the players involved in the tie
- b) Buchholz, the highest number wins;
- c) Number of wins, the highest number wins;
- d) Number of wins by black, the highest wins
- e) The highest rating

There will be no tie break matches

Robin round

- a) By the results between the players involved in the tie
- b) Sonneborg berger
- c) Number of wins, the highest number wins;
- d) Number of wins by black, the highest wins
- e) The highest rating

9. Awards:

- 9.1. The winners of each group category (both Open and Girls) will be awarded Gold medal and cup and a diploma, the second and third in each category will be awarded a medal and a diploma
- 9.2 The winners in each group category will also be awarded FIDE titles as follows:
 - 9.2.1. Open: IM title and GM norm
 - 9.2.2. Girls: WIM title and WGM norm
- 9.3. In the event of joint winners, the players sharing the same points, the players will get titles as indicated below up to maximum of 3 players:
- 9.3.1. One player in 1st position: GM or WGM norm; 2nd and 3rd Players FM or WFM;
- 9.3.2. Two players in 1st position: 1st player IM or WIM title, 2nd player IM or WIM norm and 3rd Players FM or WFM;
- 9.3.3. Three players in 1st position: 1st player IM or WIM title, 2nd and 3rd Players IM or WIM norm.
- 9.4. The winners of each group category (both Open and Girls) will be awarded personal rights to participate at the next African Chess Championships

10. Additional Competition rules

- 10.1. Important: in these championships the new regulation 6.6a of the FIDE Laws of chess will be used. Any player who arrives at the chessboard after the start of the session shall lose the game.
- 10.2. Zero-tolerance rule will apply for each round.
- 10.3. Players may only agree to a draw after the 30th move has been made by Black. Players violating this rule will be forfeited. If a player is offered a draw before the 30th move has been made by Black, he should call an arbiter. His opponent shall be punished for distracting, according to the FIDE Laws of Chess.
- 10.4. Analyzing is not allowed in the playing hall.

- 10.5. During the game the players are not allowed to go to the analyzing room or to the press room
- 10.6. Flash photography may be used only in the first five minutes of the playing session
- 10.7. Only the players and arbiters shall be allowed in the actual playing area, except with the express permission of the Chief Arbiter.
- 10.8. Players are not allowed to enter the closed area of the top boards if they don't play there themselves.
- 10.9. As long as the game is in progress a player may talk only to an arbiter or with his opponent as permitted by the Laws of Chess.
- 10.10. We assume that all the players have read the Tournament Regulations and are obliged to obey them.
- 10.11. The English text of these Tournament Regulations is the authentic version.

11. Arbiters

The Chief Arbiter for the 2013 African junior Chess Championships will be IA Nesla Adnane from Algeria.

The Continental President for Africa will - after consultation with the organizing federation - appoint his two assistants, one for each section. The rest of the Arbiters will be appointed by the organizing Federation.

12. Appeals committee

- 12.1 Before the beginning of the tournament an Appeal's Committee shall be selected during the technical meeting. This committee will consist of three members and two reserves, chosen by the players from among themselves or the representatives of national federations present. The committee will elect a chairman. The persons chosen for the committee of appeal shall represent five different federations.
- 12.2 No member of the committee will have the right to decide on questions concerning his own federation. In such cases the member concerned will have the right only to partake in the discussions in the committee.
- 12.3 Protests, including protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants, must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within 30 minutes after the round with a deposit of \$ 100 after that will not be reassigned if the appeal is dismissed.
