







2016 Zone 4.2 Individual Chess Championships

INVITATION

22nd April- 1st May 2016

Dar-es-Salaam TANZANIA Dear Friends.

Under the auspices of the African Chess Confederation, the Tanzania Chess Association has the honour of inviting Zone 4.2 Federations affiliated to the World Chess Federation (FIDE) to participate in the 2016 Zone 4.2 Individual Chess Championships.

1. 2016 Zone 4.2 Individual Chess Championships

The event will comprise an Open Section and a Women's section.

The Championships will be held from April 22, 2016 (arrival) to May 01, 2016 (departure) at the Peacock Hotel, Dar-es-Salaam, Tanzania.

2. Participants

- In accordance with FIDE regulations, the Zone 4.2 Individual Chess Championships are open to all players from federations within the Zone 4.2 region which are affiliated to FIDE.
- Federations will be allowed to enter a maximum of five (5) players in each category.
- The host federation reserves the right to field up to seven (7) players in each category and also hold a player in reserve; that can be registered if there are an odd number of participants.
- Subject to agreement with the organizers, the Continental President may allow additional participants for the tournament.

3. <u>Tournament Regulations</u>

- It is intended that the Championships will be played in accordance with FIDE regulations as a <u>9 Round Swiss System</u> tournament.
- Time control will be <u>90 minutes for the first 40 moves, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game, with an increment of 30 seconds per move starting from move one (1)</u>

- The games will be played using <u>Digital Clocks</u>; and pairings will be published on <u>www.chess-results.com</u>
- <u>Swiss Manager</u> will be used for the Championship, and players from the same Federation will not be paired together in the last round.
- Draw offers are not allowed before Black's 30th move.

4. Tie-Break

In case of a tie for the overall winner or other places, the tie will be broken as follows:

- a) By the results between the players involved in the tie
- b) Buchholz, the highest number wins;
- c) Number of wins by black, the highest wins
- d) The highest rating

5. <u>Title Awards</u>

The winner in the Open Section will be awarded International Master (IM) title whilst the winner in the Women's Section will be awarded the Woman International Master (WIM) title.

Other titles will be awarded depending on performance in accordance with FIDE title requirements.

6. Prizes

Open Section

Winner: US\$ 1,000

Second Place: US\$ 800

Third Place: US\$ 600

Fourth Place: US\$ 400

Fifth Place: US\$ 200

Women's Section

Winner: US\$ 750

Second Place: US\$ 500

Third Place: US\$ 250

7. Qualification for 2017-2018 ACC Grand Prix

The 2016 Zone 4.2 Championship is a qualification event for the 2017-2018 ACC Grand Prix.

The winners in each section will qualify for the 2017-2018 ACC Grand Prix.

8. Tournament Schedule

The tournament schedule is as follows but subject to some changes if need be. However any changes to the schedule will be communicated during the Technical Meeting before the start of 1st round.

9. Chief Arbiter & Appeals Committee

The Chief Arbiter for the 2016 Zone 4.2 Individual Chess Championships will be appointed by the ACC President.

The Appeals Committee will consist of 3 members and 2 reserves chosen from among the participating Federations.

Appeals should be submitted in writing to the Chief Arbiter within two hours (2 hours) after the end of the round in question, with a Euro 100 deposit. The deposit is refundable, if the appeal is successful.

10. Board and Lodging

- All additional players, officials and accompanying persons from participating federations will lodge at *Euros 60* per person per day (sharing) or *Euros 75* per person per day (single room). This cost includes 3 meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- All payments related to board and lodging must be effected before the DEADLINE DATE, which will be the April 8, 2016.
- Players, officials and accompanying persons who arrive before the official
 arrival date or depart after official departure date will be expected to
 arrange their own accommodation for the extra days or pay for the
 additional days at the tournament lodging venue the Sophia House Hotel
 and Apartments.
- Participating Federations will receive free board and lodging for one player in each category.

 Important note: all payments must be made to the account of the Tanzania Chess Association as indicated in item 11. Bank Details or upon arrival subject to a specific request to the Organizers. If payments are not received before the start of the competition, players will not be allowed to participate in the tournament

11.. FIDE Fees

In accordance with FIDE regulations both official players and additional players shall be required to pay FIDE fees of €70 per player.

One player in the Women Category and one in the Open category from each federation will be recognized as official player while all others will be additional players.

Fees must be paid into Tanzania Chess Association Account by the deadline date of **April 8, 2016**.

12. Accreditation

Each federation should send names together with Passport size photos for all their Players, Officials and Accompanying persons by **April 8, 2016**.

13. Registration Fees:

- The Registration Fee for each participating player is 100 Euros and must be paid into the Tanzania Chess Association account before April 8, 2016.
- Payments may be made also upon arrival; provided a request is made to the Organizers. Players whose Fees remain unpaid at the start of the Technical Meeting will not be allowed to participate to the tournament.
- Only Federations can register players.
- The Registration Fee for each official and each accompanying person will be 100 Euros.
- No refunds will be made for any player, official or accompanying person who fails to make it to the Tournament after paying Registration or FIDE fees.

- Registration Forms for entries are attached herein; Federation officials
 must fill them in and return them to the designated Tanzania Chess
 Association officials on or before *April 8, 2016* by e-mail to confirm entry.
- All registered players, officials and accompanying persons are entitled to:-
 - Free Transfer to and from Julius Nyerere International Airport or Ubungo Bus Terminal on the arrival and departure dates.
 - For players, free bottled water, coffee or tea and snacks during time of play (Included in your All-Inclusive package)
 - Free Bulletins after each round for players and coaches.

15. Local Currency

The Local Currency is the Tanzania Shilling (TZS) 2,167 Tanzania Shilling (TZS) is equivalent to 1 (One) United States Dollar (US\$) and 2,421 TZS to 1 EUR as at 9th February, 2016.

16. Travel Arrangements

All travelling arrangements and costs to and from Julius
 Nyerere International Airport or Ubungo Bus Terminal are to be taken

care of by respective Federations or respective players participating in the tournament.

 Organizers will meet participants and accompanying persons at Julius Nyerere International Airport or Ubungo Bus Terminal provided that full itinerary for each participant and their accompanying persons are communicated to the organizer by April 6, 2016.

17. VISA and YELLOW FEVER VACCINE

 For delegations coming from countries requiring entry visas into Tanzania, these can be obtained from Tanzanian Embassies or Consulate Offices in your country. Most countries can also obtain Visas on arrival at the Airport (please crosscheck this before setting off).

We will avail an official invitation to delegations that need a copy for VISA processing.

 It's compulsory in Tanzania for travelers to have a Valid Yellow Fever Vaccine Book.

18. Deadline

- Entry forms must be filled by the respective Federation and returned to the host federation not later than 8th April 2016. This date is the registration deadline.
- Late registration attracts a penalty charge of **50 Euros**. The host Federation will thereafter reserve the rights to accept or reject any player.
