WORLD JUNIOR UNDER-20 CHAMPIONSHIPS

Approved by the 1982 General Assembly and amended by the 1984, 1985, 1986, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1993, 1994,1995, 1997, 1998 & 2002 General Assemblies.

General Regulations & Rules

1. The Championships shall be governed by the General Regulations for FIDE Competitions and these Rules.

Participation

- 2. There shall be a separate event for girls.
- 3. All chess players who shall not have reached the age of 20 on January 1st of the year in which the Championships are held are eligible to participate.
- 4. The following have a personal right and are entitled to participate provided they fulfil the condition of Rule 3 above:
 - a. The top 3 players of the previous edition.
 - b. The Continental Junior Champions preceding this edition.
 - c. The top 6 (4 for Girls) Junior U20 players from the FIDE Rating List as of January 1st of the current year. World Youth U18 and U16 champions of the year preceding this edition.
- 5. In addition to the players mentioned in Rule 4 above, each FIDE member federation shall have the right to send one participant.
- 6. FIDE member federations shall have the right to send as many additional players as they wish.

Schedule and System

7. There shall be a minimum of 11 rounds.

Financial Regulations

8. The Organizing Committee shall provide free board and lodging (in twin share rooms with bath and/or shower) for players mentioned in Rules 4 & 5 above.
