4. List of Lecturers: The Council re-examined the Lecturer's List and decided to remove Lev Albur, Boris Gulko, Mark Dvoretzky and Yuri Razuvaev on the basis of either inactivity or lack of cooperation with TRG. Also, TRG welcomed Sam Palatnik, Kevin O'Connell and Martha Fierro (the first woman) as new lecturers (TRG-04-Lecturers List).

5. FIDE/TRG Awards - Awarding Ceremony (17:00): The awards ceremony took place as scheduled and statuses & diplomas were presented by FIDE President Kirsan Ilyumzhinov.

6. Various: Council's members informed and discuss with the audience various subjects concerning training systems and evaluated their countries' systems.

All Council's decisions/proposals will come in force after the next General Assembly's approval.

TRG OLYMPIAD 2010 REPORT

FIDE Trainers Committee was created in 2000 during Istanbul Olimpiad, and was led till 2009 by famous trainer IGM Yuri Razuvaev from Russia. The base was established in this time and it is FIDE Trainers system, with 5 levels titles, which were approved during Olimpiad in Calvia, 2004.

Trainers titles were new and process of its acceptance was slow, but now we can proudly announce that all World top trainers entered FIDE Trainers System!

Few Trainers Academies were established, among them Singapore, Berlin and New York. We understood that trainers are key force in chess development, but level of trainers in many countries is not sufficient. It happened, because trainers education was seriously conducted in Eastern Europe, especially in former Soviet Union. So, our aim was to educate chess trainers in academies plus to try to create manuals for trainers, as the lack of official educational programmes is the most serious problem in chess development in many countries. It is long process and many problems are on these way.

But our Seminars were very successful and many trainers took part in them. But we understood the problems of costs of participation in these Seminars and started second, cheaper way of education of trainers-to conduct the Seminars together with National Federations. Such Federations as Switzerland, Spain, Iraq, India, South Africa, Cyprus were firstly to start these programme.

In 2009 Committee was upgraded to status of Commission and IGM Adrian Mikhalchishin was appointed as Chairman. The most important decision was to establish the real position of the Secretary of The Commission and creation of own web page. The communication with trainers, Federations and other FIDE Commissions were seriously improved. But the most important-all documents and decisions were updated by our secretary.

TRG as we are classified, decided to improve the image and role of trainers in chess, establishing 5 AWARDS, dedicated to the famous World trainers and Trainers Hall of fame was created.

As we are not able to create universal TRAINERS MANUALS for 3 levels at the moment, we started to publish on our site TRAINERS SURVEYS –useful materials for trainers and players. Free of charge.

List of the best books for trainers were completed in Russian, English and Spanish, thanking to TRG Advisors Mr. Bykhovsky, Bosch and Illescas.

We conducted in 2009 -10 much more Seminars as before. Additionally we established trainers education during World, Continental Juniors and Olimpiads free of charge. For these reason we communicate intensively with Continental Presidents, IOOC SPORT FUND ARIS, National Federations CACDEC, FIDE Secretary and Treasurer, which supported us with real and serious assistance.

We evaluated different educational programmes and selected the best and we are ready to start chess education in Afrika.

Our future plan is to start Trainers Seminars on internet, to reduce the costs for trainers to minimum.

We closely cooperate with CHESSBASE on the project of online training and in creation of Training DVDs by the World top trainers.

We plan to help education for players from CACDEC countries and next year we will start Chess holidays in Slovenia and Greece.

One future Award is proposed for the most educational annotations in books and magazines, remembering the late editor of Chess Informant ZDENKO KRNIC.

We plan to support publishing literature for trainers-we plan to support translation to English two books yearly and distribute them via CACDEC.

TRG plans to cooperate with other FIDE Commissions much closer. Now we had very good working relations with CACDEC, we want improvement of cooperation with Chess in Schools and Rules Commissions. TRG consists of extremely experienced IGM, who can contribute a lot to the development of the rules.

Our proposal from Dresden 2008 about the right of reserve player to be placed on every board was accepted as logical, but never implemented. We expect, that other FIDE Commissions will support TRG.
