What we offer?


- ► The programme is aimed at providing chess training to school going children to help them become better individuals and excel in all walks of life.

Titled players in INDIA




How we will work?

Action Plan

- ► AICF has already conducted 3 chess in schools seminars in Delhi, Chennai and Jalgaon. 100 trainers has been trained with the help of FIDE.
- AICF Plans to train 200 more trainers before January 2013.
- 300 trained trainers will train 3000 school teachers from 3000 schools.
- ▶ DAV, Kendriya Vidyalaya, CBSE, DPS already initiated their inter school tournaments. We plan to cover 4000 schools in Chess in Schools program and CiS Delhi aim at enrolling 100 schools in the next 2 years.
