SA has excellent relations with all countries. Chess South Africa will work with Home Affairs to ensure visas for all participants.

### Exceptions, if any, and reasons:

None that Chess South Africa is aware of.

### Name of Meeting/Tournament hall and its distance from accommodation:

Sun City Super Bowl. The accommodation is within walking distance from the playing venue, all on-site. The organisers will however make shuttles available.

### Travel connections and reductions for participants, officials and accompanying persons:

There are direct international flights to Johannesburg. The owners of Sun City will then transport all players, officials and accompanying persons to the venue by bus. There are also private charters available to Sun City. South African Tourism will offer up to 15% reduction in flights when traveling with South African Airways and Emirates. Terms and conditions apply.

Accommodation and meals are provided at the hotels which are high standard three to five star hotels. There will be 1-2 persons per room.


