



**The Chess Federation of the Kyrgyz Republic invites you to the
Asian Junior & Girls Under-20 Chess Championships
Organized in Bishkek from 2nd till 12th October, 2015**

INVITATION

1. Invitation

1.1. On behalf of the Asian Chess Federation and FIDE, the Kyrgyz Chess Federation has the honor to invite all Asian National Chess Federations affiliated to FIDE to participate in the 2015 Asian Junior Chess Championships under 20 from 2nd (arrival) to 12th October (departure) 2015 in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.

2. Participation

- 2.1. Each National Federation can enter one (1) player (Open & Girls) categories, totaling a maximum of two (2) invited Players.
- 2.2. The players placed 1-3 in the previous Championship and the Asian Boys (Girls) - 18 champions of 2014, the year preceding this edition, will have a personal right to participate in the tournament if they fulfill the condition of Article 2.4 and will be accepted as official players.
- 2.3. Additional (extra) players per category from National Federations can also be registered.
- 2.4. Entitled to participate are chess players from the Federations in Zones 3.1. to 3.7. who shall not have reached the age of 20 before January 1st 2015.

3. Organization

3.1. The Asian Chess Federation president represents the interests of the Continent and is empowered to take the final decision on all questions relating to the Championship as a whole. A Technical Delegate shall be appointed by the Asian Chess Federation president for inspection and final report.

4. Registration

4.1. At least 3 months (**before 2 July 2015**) before the beginning of the Tournament, Federations should register their intentions to participate stating the expected number of participants. This is a Preliminary Registration in order to ascertain number of hotel rooms required.

At least 2 months (**before 2 August 2015**) before the beginning of the Tournament, Federations should submit their Final Registration of participants. This date is the

registration deadline. Late registration shall bear a \$50 fine. Copies of the entry should be sent to the Asian Chess Federation and respective Zone President.

- 4.2. The complete registration form must include the surname, first name, FIDE ID number, FIDE rating and title, and passport number of each player and each accompanying person. It must also include the name, telephone, fax number and email of the Delegation chief and of the federation official in charge.
- 4.3. A digital scan of the passport and ID photo of each player and each accompanying person must be sent by email to the Organizing Committee.
- 4.4. All travel expenses must be paid by the participants or their National Federation.
- 4.5. Every player (invited, extra or by personal right) and every accompanying person has to pay to the organizers the amount of US \$100 Participation Fee on registration to the tournament organizer.
- 4.6. All Players are obliged to wear uniforms that represent their National Federation and/or the National Flag. Shorts, Slippers, Sun glasses, Sport caps and revealing attire are not allowed

5. Entry Fees

- 5.1. In accordance with FIDE regulations an entry fee of US \$75 is required for each invited player. This amount must be paid to the Organizing Committee at the moment of the registration.
- 5.2. For each additional (extra) player, an entry fee of US \$150 is required. This amount must be paid to the Organizing Committee at the moment of the registration.

6. Hotel Accommodation

- 6.1. All players and accompanying persons should be registered through the organizers at the designated official hotel "Ak Keme Hotel".
- 6.2. Free board and lodging will be provided to the invited players from noon of 2nd October to noon of 12th October. The Organizers shall accommodate 2 or 3 invited participants in shared rooms.
- 6.3. All participants and all accompanying persons are obliged to lodge at the Official Hotel. The playing hall is located in the official hotel.
- 6.4. Hotel payment for all extra players and accompanying persons must be made in advance on arrival in Bishkek.
- 6.5. Cost for full board and lodging (with breakfast, lunch and dinner) for additional (extra) players and accompanying persons:
 - a) In double (or triple) normal rooms: US \$65 per person per day.
 - b) In single normal room: US \$99 per person per day.

7. Format

- 7.1. The Championships will be played according to the Swiss System of 9 Rounds. Time control is 90 minutes for the whole game with 30 second increments per move from move 1. In the last round, players from the same country who have more than 50% shall not be paired together.

9. Chief Arbiter and his Assistants

- 9.1. The Asian Chess Federation president will, after consultation with the organizing federation, nominate the Chief Arbiter, as well as the necessary assistant arbiters and other officials.
- 9.2. The Chief Arbiter may, in consultation with the Asian Chess Federation, and with the approval of the Asian Chess Federation President, issue additional written regulations to inform the exact playing hours and take care of other details not covered by these regulations.
- 9.3. Protests, including protests against decisions of the Chief Arbiter or his assistants, must be submitted in writing to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within one hour after completion of the playing session. A protest shall be submitted with an accompanying fee of \$100 or its equivalent in local currency. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned otherwise it shall be forfeited to the organizing federation.

10. Appeals Committee

- 10.1. The Chairman of the Appeals Committee shall be nominated by the Asian Chess Federation President in consultation with the organizing federation. The Committee shall be composed of five members and two reserves, all from different Federations, chosen from among the representatives of national federations present.
- 10.2. No member of the committee will have the right to decide on questions concerning his own federation. In such cases the member concerned will have the right only to partake in the discussions in the committee.

11. Designation of the Winner

- 11.1. The order of the players is determined according to the number of points obtained. If at the end of the tournament two or more players are tied, the tie shall be broken by the tiebreak systems in the following order:
 - a) Direct Encounter.
 - b) The greater number of wins

- c) Buchholz
- d) Buchholz Cut 1, Cut 2, etc.

11.2. In case the above does not produce a decision, the players remaining tied will be proclaimed joint winners of the Asian Junior Champion.

12. Visas

For those who need visas, send all passport copy to Organizing Committee before (2nd August 2015) at email and fax number below, the Organizing Committee shall issue invitations.
