



FIDE Trainers' Commission (TRG)

FIDE Trainers' Seminar - Agadir 2015

1. Objective: To educate and certify Chess-Teachers on an international basis. This FIDE Trainers' Seminar for FIDE School Instructor Diploma is approved by FIDE and the FIDE Trainers' Commission (TRG). The seminar is co-organised by the FIDE, the African Chess Confederation (ACC), the FIDE Trainers' Commission (TRG), the FIDE Chess in Schools Commission (CiS) and the Federation Royale Marocaine des Echecs (FRME).

2. Dates: October 18th to 20th, 2015.

3. Location: Hotel Anezi Tower, Avenue Mohamed V., Agadir, Morocco.

4. Participants - Qualification / Professional Skills Requirements of School Instructor (SI) Title:

4.1. Scope - Mission

4.1.1. Introducing the school student to the basic chess regulations and broaden the base of chess players worldwide.

4.2. Qualification - Professional Skills Requirements

4.2.1. Teaching or will teach in School environment.

4.2.2. Certain knowledge of psychology and pedagogy.

4.2.3. Good knowledge of teaching the chess basics.

4.2.4. Approved by the federation and the state/nation.

4.3. Title Award

4.3.1. By successful participation in a 15-hour TRG Seminar.

4.3.2. By accepting the FIDE seminar fee of 100 euros (if required).

4.3.3. By accepting the title award fee of 30 euros (no licence fee furthermore).

4.3.4. By accepting any other participation fee.

5. Number of Participants: 40 participants maximum will be allowed for the class (first come-first served basis).

6. Order of Events:

7. Lectures / Exercises: The FIDE Trainers Seminar will take-up 15 hours. The lectures will be conducted in the Arabic/French language and a lesson hour equals to 45 minutes. A projector and a microphone will be in use during the lectures.

8. Trainer Certificate / Diploma:

1.3. Procedures / Financial:

a. After successful graduation from the seminar course, each participant will receive a participation certificate signed by the Lecturers/Seminar Leaders.

b. After the detailed report submission by the Lecturers/Seminar Leaders to TRG, the latter will submit the title applications /proposals to FIDE for approval by an official body (PB, EB or GA).

c. Following approval, the trainer will receive the official diploma and badge (the badge shall include the photograph of the trainer and the licence validity) from FIDE, if the following conditions are fulfilled:

c1. Requirements (Qualification) for each title as described above.

c2. Diploma of the successful participation in the FIDE Trainer Seminar (except for FST).

c3. Written examinations (except for FST).

c4. Payments of FIDE fees (participation and titles), according to the Regulations.

d. The FIDE fee for a participant to a TRG seminar is 100 euros and it must be paid to the affiliated federation/body, co-organizer of the Seminar. The affiliated federation /body, co-organizer will be invoiced by FIDE for the total amount of the participants' fees. It must be noted that the seminar fee, under certain circumstances, could be varied from 0 to 100 euros.

e. It is allowed for a participant to pay his Title Fee in advance to the affiliated federation/body co-organizer or to FIDE directly. In this case he/she must inform FIDE in writing of this action. In the case that his/her title fails to be approved by FIDE, the Title Fee is not refundable.

f. A titled Trainer will be charged a 'Licence Fee' after two calendar years have passed since the title was awarded. Each licence will be valid for four (4) years. (ex) World Champions and the FST of the 2004 Direct Approval (founders) are exempt from these licence regulations. Failing to fulfil the licence's obligations will lead to a suspension from the trainers' title lists.

g. English is the official language between TRG, federations and Trainers.

h. GMs and IMs do not have to attend a semi-

nar, but would be given the lowest title together with all the TRG literature (optional).

9. Costs: The costs for travel, board & lodging will be born by the sending federation, club or participant. The seminar fee will be on 330 € which includes the FIDE fee (100 €) and the title fee (30 €), as well as the Accommodation costs. All refreshments and snacks throughout the seminar, as access to Internet and handouts and examination, will be free. A relative book (TRG Foundation Trainer Guide) containing all the lectures will be distributed for free among the registered participants.

10. Enrolment: The deadline for enrolment / payment: October 17th, 2015.

11. Board and Lodging: According to special arrangement by the organizers.

12. Lecturers: The program will be fulfilled by GM-FST-IA **Slim Bouaziz**. The Assisting Lecturers will be FT-IA-IO **Bechir Messaoudi** (Psychopedagogist) and IA **Akkour Abdelfattah**. The lectures are prepared by TRG members.
