1. Welcome

The Chairman Mr Herbert began by welcoming everyone to Baku and expressing thanks to commission members for their support over the year. He then gave an overview of the agenda for the meeting. He explained that due to budget constraints and at the request of the FIDE Treasurer there was no Core Commission meeting.

2. 2015 Statistics Review

Martin Huba presented FIDE Statistics 2015. See attached. The big conclusion is that there is more activity year on year. More rated games, more FIDE tournaments and an ever decreasing number of countries with no active rated players. Of 187 Federations only 14 have no active FIDE rated players.

Federations were encouraged to use the Statistics as part of their marketing both to potential sponsors, sports and tourism authorities. Paul Spiller (New Zealand) said they had done a study on the economic impact of the 3 Queenstown chess events. The study concluded the events had created three million dollars of extra revenue and business for Queenstown.

It was agreed that in the next publication of the statistics the bottom performers should also be published and as well as statistics by gender and regional grouping below Continent.

3. 2015 16 Development List

The 2017-2018 Development List will be based on October 1st FIDE Rating List and published in FIDE Handbook on FIDE Web Site in January 2017. This is the chosen date due to it being close to the end of the Olympiad when there is the most activity and change to the average of the top ten rated players in each country.

A forecast, based on the September 1st 2016 FIDE Rating List, was presented to give Federations a preview of their Development Level. See attached. Mr Herbert cautioned that Federations near the boundary between two levels could see a change in their position based on Olympiad Results and September activity by their top players.

The Chairman referenced the Development Olympiad Performance report done by the Secretary in 2015. He pointed out that the performances very closely resembled each countries Development Level. It can be found on the FIDE website.

The Commission was requested to revisit the used of other criteria in the allocation of Federations to different level.

4. Development Goals 2017 2018

The Commission has worked on the premise that every Federation should at a minimum seek to:

1. Have an annual National Championship
2. Have annual National Schools, Youth and Junior Championships
3. Participate in the Olympiad

Ultimately, each Federation should be aspiring to graduate out of 'Development.' The challenge is finding the best way to achieve this based on the Federations circumstance..

It was noted that in the current list of 32 countries in level 5, 20 are from African Federations.

Continents will be engaged to focus part of their Development Budget for 2017-2018 on projects which will gradually lessen the number of Level 5 Federations.

With respect to Olympiad participation, this continues to improve with 171 countries paired in the Open draw which constitutes an all-time record.

It is a continued goal of helping Federations to improve the playing standards. For Baku the Commission has helped fund 12 Federations (3 from each continent) with a coach.

5. 2016 Budget & Funding

The FIDE Treasurer has proposed 2017 Development of 200,000 Euros. See attached.

The Treasurer also queried the possibility of the Commission finding additional sources of income. This is difficult and the answer is both yes and no. On the one hand the Commission enables the individual Federations to become more active. In doing this they provide more income to FIDE. However, to get this process going these Federations benefit from the rebate scheme which costs money to FIDE and which appears as a cost on the Development Commission budget.

6. Travel Grant Scholarship

Unless there are changes to the proposed 2017 budget and current 2016 situation, the travel grants programmes will have to be suspended. Continental President for Africa, Mr Ncube asked for a widening of the definition for those eligible for a grant to include winners of the various Continental Competitions and committed to putting forward a proposal for consideration by the Development Commission.





Federations with FIDE rated active players





- 19 out of 189 FIDE member federations have no FIDE titled player (CM, FM, IM, GM, WCM, WFM, WIM and WGM).
- Africa has 570 FIDE titled players that represents 3% of the FIDE total.
- Americas have 2800 FIDE titled players that represents 17% of the FIDE total.
- Asia has 2039 FIDE titled players that represents 12% of the FIDE total.
- Europe totalling 11 229 of FIDE titled players has the share of 68% in FIDE.





The trend is very positive. Open tournaments are mainly about the mass promotion of chess, about giving possibilities to weaker players to play with stronger ones. The increase of standard FIDE open tournaments is by almost 27% compared to 2014. There is a potential in the area of rapid and blitz tournaments.






