1. Participants & Registration:

- 1.1. Open to all FIDE-rated players with a **Standard (std.) rating** of **1500 and above** (as of 1st February 2017).
- 1.2. Last day of registration & payment is 10th March 2017.
- 1.3. Registration is only accepted online via the following link www.dubaichess.ae/do17-
- 1.4. All participating players accept to fully comply with the regulations of the tournament and the organizer.
- 1.5. All participating players and accompany persons accept to fully comply with the rules and regulations of the United Arab Emirates.

2. Number of Rounds & Time Control:

- 2.1. **9 Rounds** Swiss System.
- 2.2. Time Control: 90 minutes + 30 seconds increment per move for the whole game.
- 2.3. **Delay Time:** 30-minute delay will apply.

 - 9.3.1. For Indian citizens, last page of the passport is required for visa purposes.
- 9.4. Minor accompany persons applying via Dubai Chess Club require a separate passport to process an entry visa.



- 9.5. Entry visas to the UAE will be issued for eligible participants subject to the approval of the General Directorate of Residency & Foreigner Affairs - UAE and will be valid for 60 days from the date of arrival.
