## 8. Tournament groups and entry fee (including rating fee)

**Tournament A - Open for chess players with ELO ratings 2100 and more** Entry fee: 150 PLN (or 35 euro), including rating fee.

The organizer has right to invite to the tournament A no more than 10 players with lower ELO rating. Entry fee for these players is 200 PLN or (50 euro).

GM's play for free.

The tournament will be registered with FIDE for ELO rating.

**Tournament B - Open for chess players with ratings ELO below 2100** Entry fee: 120 PLN (or 30 euro), including rating fee.

The tournament will be registered with FIDE for ELO rating.

National norms and titles can be gained.

#### **Tournament C - Chess players under 12**

Entry fee: 70 PLN (or 20 euro), including rating fee.

National norms can be gained. Notation of the game is obligatory.

Children may contact with parents, trainers or counsellors only in the presence of an arbiter.

## 9. Participation

- Registration to <u>festiwal.laskera.2017@gmail.com</u> by May 15, 2017 is obligatory: surname, name, country, date of birth, FIDE rating, Polish Chess federation rating.
- Entry fee must be paid till May 15, 2017.

- The players registered on June 12, 2017 will be invited to the Festival from the second round (the organizer and the main arbiter have rights to decide differently).
- Entry fee will not be given back. After May 15, 2017 the entry fee is 50 PLN higher.

### 9. Hotels

a) The main organizer's hotel is Hotel Mieszko in Gorzów Wlkp.\*\*\* (82 Kosynierów Gdyńskich street, 600 m from playing hall (http://www.hotel-mieszko.pl/).

- Single room (bath, breakfast, Internet free) 180 PLN (or 45 euro) per day.
- Double room (bath, breakfast, Internet free) 120 PLN (or 30 euro) per day per person. There are two separate beds in the rooms.

b) "Azyl" Hotel in Gorzów Wlkp. (45 Chopin street, 1000 m from the playing hall) – (with breakfast) – 80 PLN (or 20 euro). Dinners (20 PLN) and supper (15 PLN) may be ordered.

The participants invited by the organizer are placed in Mieszko Hotel. Other participants will also be placed in hotels by the organizer.

## 10. System

Tournaments A and B are played according to Swiss system, 9 rounds, 90 minutes for the first 40 moves, followed by 30 minutes for the rest of the game, with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Tournament C is played according to Swiss system, 9 rounds, 60 minutes per game, with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

All tournaments will be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Competition Rules.

The player with more than 30-minutes delay loses the game.

The game and concept of chess is based on the assumption that everyone involved/concerned observe existing rules and regulations and attaches the greatest importance to fair play and good sportsmanship.

If the Main Arbiter will have any reason to suspect that the game is played not according to ethical rules:

- the result of the game was agreed before the first move
- the chess players use electronic or other help

then he will act.

Three prizes for the best women (900, 600, 300 PLN) in each tournament.

Prize fund guaranteed – 40.000 PLN. The special prize will be drawn at closing ceremony – 150 PLN.

#### Info:

- All children under 12 participating in the Festival will be given gifts.
- According to Polish rules the prizes under 760 (170 euro) are tax-free. Otherwise the tax is 10%.
- The prizes are not divided
- The participants must take away the prizes only at closing ceremony (otherwise the prize gets lost).

### 12. Insurance

The participants insure themselves.

### 13. Final resolutions

Registration to the tournament means that the participant accepts the organizer's announcement.

Otherwise the decisions are undertaken by the Main Arbiter (chess) or the Director of the Festival (organizational).
