After this, the procedure is as follows:

1. FIDE will approve (or disapprove) your proposed titles in the next FIDE PB/EB/GA meeting.
2. An invoice will be send to your federation, according to your awarded title (FIDE Trainer = 200 euros * FIDE Instructor = 100 euros * National Instructor = 50 euros * Developmental Instructor = 50 euros). Red colour means that existing title remains.
3. After approval and payment the title certificates, pins and badges will be sent to your federations. It would be advisable to pay directly your title fees by the end of June (see attached FTS-CEV 2017-FIDE Payments). If you face any problems or need more advice, please contact accounts@fide.com.

We have also sent you your Participation Diploma, which you can print.

Please forward this letter to your federation officials, as they should be informed on your results.
