Last Date of Entry: 31st March 2018

However, entry will be accepted till April 5, with late fee of \$5.

And at the venue till 18:00 hrs on April 12, with a late fee of \$15.

No request towards waiver of entry fee will be entertained.

The entry fees once paid is non-refundable and non-transferable.

The organizer reserves right to reject any entry without giving any reason thereof.

Tournament Rules:

System of Play:

The tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess and FIDE Swiss System with 9 rounds.

Accelerated pairing should be done for the first two rounds.

Time Control:

90 minutes plus 30 second increment from move 1 for entire game.

Tie-Break:

If needed, the following tie-break shall be applied to determine final ranking. However, Cash prize will not be shared.

1. Direct Encounter
2. Buccholz Cut 1
3. Buccholz
4. Most Black
5. The greater number of victories

The Drawn Game:

The players cannot draw the game before 30th move of black without consent of the arbiter.

Default Time:

30 minutes.

Arbitration of Protest:

Objection, if any to the decision of Chief Arbiter, shall be made in writing with a protest fee of NRs. 2,500/- (\$25) within 30 minutes of the incident. The amount would be refunded if the appeal is upheld.

Appeal Committee:

A five member committee of Appeals (inclusive of 2 reserves) shall be formed on the technical meeting.

Interpretation:

For further interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any aspect not covered by the said tournament prospectus, the decision of the tournament director shall be final. The Tournament Director has every right to make any changes to these rules.

Instruction for Players:

Players are not allowed to carry bags, mobile phones and other electronic devices on the playing arena.

Weather:

The weather condition of Kathmandu City during April will be pleasant.

Venue & Official Hotel:



Godavari Village Resort is the official venue of **Kathmandu Open International GM Chess Tournament 2018**. This resort is located on the south-east part of Kathmandu valley, which is only about 13 kilometers from Tribhuwan International Airport(TIA).

Accommodation: (Only for Chess Tournament)

- All **GM's** will be provided free accommodation on double sharing with full boarding.
- All **IM/WGM/WIM** have to pay **\$150** per person for full board on double sharing.
- All other players have to **pay \$150** per person for full board on triple sharing.
- Accompany have to pay **\$150** per person for full board on triple sharing and **\$10** extra for administration cost (Airport to hotel transfer, Identity Card etc.)
