

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1.2. FIDE is concerned exclusively with chess activities. FIDE is democratically established and bases itself on the principles of equal rights of its members. FIDE is a non-profit making organisation. It rejects discriminatory treatment for national, political, racial, social or religious reasons or on account of gender. It observes strict neutrality in the internal affairs of the national chess federations.

- a. FIDE events (competitions, congresses, meetings) may be hosted only by Federations where free access is generally assured to representatives of all Federations.
- b. The General Assembly may take exceptions for reasons of state of war or severe violence between countries, only on a three quarter majority vote.

2.1. Members of FIDE are national chess federations which have principal authority over chess activities in their own countries and which have been admitted to FIDE as member-federations if they acknowledge the FIDE Statutes and develop activities not contrary to those statutes. Only one federation of each country can be affiliated to FIDE. In addition FIDE can grant the status of provisional member to chess federations, in accord with Article 2.7. For new members, the country of the federation (with the same boundaries) must be a country or territory that is a member of the International Olympic Committee.

Dear Sir,

This man namely Amin Malik is throwing mud on everyone who doesn't agree with him. After getting a notification from Pakistan Sports Board which itself is based on a conspiracy (Matter is in Court) he is using such language and accusing everyone which is not acceptable. This man has been given undue importance that's why he is trying to rise above his station.

I think its time to clear the role of Pakistan Sports Board (PSB).

The perception that the recognition of PSB is mandatory for National Sports bodies to exist or to represent Pakistan at international level is totally wrong and baseless. There are many National Sports bodies in Pakistan which are not recognized by PSB but they are affiliated with their international Federations and working properly. Even for many years in recent past Pakistan Olympic Association (POA) was not recognized by PSB but it did not affect its functioning. Furthermore according to the judgement of Supreme Court of Pakistan (copy of judgement can be furnished)) PSB can not control or regulate any Sports body which is not affiliated with it.

As far I remember this group went to court 6 times against Chess Federation of Pakistan but never succeeded. Instead two of these 6 cases were ended in our favor, one on merit and one on non prosecution. 04 court cases are under progress at the moment.

One more point which may be relevant to state is that PSB is a subordinate department of Ministry of IPC. The Ministry of IPC signed an agreement with IOC and OCA in 2014. In that agreement (Laussane agreement) Ministry of IPC Govt. of Pakistan clearly stated "We agree with the point that the only Sports Federations recognized by their respective IFs are to be considered genuine Federations". (copy of agreement is available)

There are many more points to be added but keeping your precious time in view I would conclude with that Sports bodies usually seek affiliation with PSB to reap the benefits associated to it such as annual grant etc but any sports body including Chess Federation of Pakistan is not under any kind of legal obligation at all to be recognized by Pakistan Sports Board (PSB).

Mr Amin Malik

I have received this mail from the Asian Chess Federation. I am appalled by your behaviour. I am the secretary of Indian Chess Federation, one of the biggest in the world in terms of events and numbers.

I am also the elected commissioner for the FIDE elections this year and I don't think you are in any position to pass judgments on me.

The disputed "fake association" according to you is the other party which is an affiliate of FIDE. And according to the other party you are fake. Being the FIDE affiliate, they have sent teams in the last Asian Youth 2018 and University Championships 2018.

As far as I know, there are multiple cases in Pakistan courts over this and the only solution to this dispute is either by mutual consent between you two parties or by the Pakistani courts. The FIDE or the Asian Federation cannot resolve your disputes unless the impending cases are settled or you two reach an amicable solution.

Calling me incompetent can probably give you a kick, but the fact remains that you have stopped a team to participate in Commonwealth Championship.

If you think stopping a seven-year old child to participate in such prestigious Championships makes you a leader or gives you a position of strength, may God be with you.

I cannot stoop to your levels so I would end here by suggesting that you resolve problems in your home first before pointing fingers at FIDE or Asian Chess Federation or me.
