


REGULATIONS
12th International Chess Tournament, Tashkent (OPEN),
Memorial of Georgy Agzamov, the first grandmaster of Uzbekistan

1. Tournament Classification

The Tournament is organized with the following objectives:

- To fulfill the decree of the President of the Republic Uzbekistan from 7th June 2017 regarding measures on the way of further development of physical culture and sport,
- Engagement of youth, amateurs and qualified chess players to participate in chess competitions and tournaments,
- Popularization and development of chess in Uzbekistan,
- Preservation and multiplication of cultural and sports traditions,
- Development of skills of Uzbekistan chess players.

2. Host Organizations.

The general management and organization of the competition is carried out by the Uzbekistan Chess Federation (hereinafter UCF), in cooperation with the Uzbekistan State Physical culture and sports Committee. The direct management of the tournament is entrusted to the Board of Arbiters.

3. Time and Venue.

The Tournament takes place in the city of Tashkent from April 22nd (arrival) till May 1st (departure), 2017. Final registration is on April 22nd from 10.00 to 16.00.

4. Tournament System.

The Tournament is a 9-round Swiss in two groups – main group A and group B for the juniors under 12 years. Once per tournament there will be played two rounds in one day.

Time controls: 90 minutes and a 30-second increment per move starting from move one.

5. Tournament Participants and Conditions.

The participation is free of charge for:

- Junior Uzbekistan champions 2018 under 14, 16, 18 years,
- Three places from Uzbekistan Men and Women's Championship Final 2017,
- Places 1 to 3 in the Uzbekistan Senior Championship 2017 (men),
- Chess players with international titles IM, GM;
- Chess players with FIDE rating not less than 2400.

Fees for the participants from Uzbekistan in the A Group:

- For chess players with FIDE rating 2300-2399, the tournament fee is 200 000 sums,
- For chess players with FIDE rating 2200-2299 — 300 000 sums,

- For chess players with FIDE rating 2100-2199 — 400 000 sums,
- For chess players with FIDE rating 2000-2099 — 480 000 sums,
- For chess players with a rating below 2000 — 600 000 sums,
- For chess players without FIDE rating – 700 000 sums,
- A 50% discount is provided for seniors 60 years old or older.

Fees for the international participants in the A Group:

- For chess players with FIDE rating 2300-2399, the tournament fee is 50 US dollars,
- For chess players with FIDE rating 2200-2299 — 75 US dollars,
- For chess players with FIDE rating 2100-2199 — 100 US dollars,
- For chess players with FIDE rating 2000-2099 — 120 US dollars,
- For chess players with a rating below 2000 — 150 US dollars,
- For chess players without FIDE rating - 175 US dollars,
- A 50% discount is provided for seniors 60 years old or older.

Fee for the participants from Uzbekistan in the B Group – 250 000 sums,

Fees for the international participants in the B Group: 50 US dollars.

Residents of Uzbekistan should transfer their fees to the mentioned below account in Uzbek sums according to their FIDE rating from 1st April 2018, no later than 15th April 2018.

The UCF will consider all the applications and selectively, upon a compulsory preliminary agreement, accepts 10 grandmasters with FIDE rating 2450 - 2600 on the following conditions:

Full-board and one place in a double room and payment of airfare (1-month, economy class) not exceeding 500 USA dollars. Accommodation is provided from 22nd April (after 14.00) to 1st May (before 12.00).

Upon agreement with UCF grandmasters – members of national Uzbekistan team might be provided with accommodation during the event. In addition, UCF reserves the right to accept chess players with outstanding achievements and merits on special conditions.

6. Accommodation.

The official tournament venue and hotel shall be in the Republic Specialized Youth Chess School.

7. Determination of winners and prizes.

Winners are determined by number points scored and, in case of a tie, by the following tie breaks:

1) Direct encounter, 2) Performance, 3) The number of wins, 4) Buchholz.

If participants have equal scores their prizes will not be shared and will be distributed according to the abovementioned tie breaks. Prize fund might be provided in national currency.

If one player wins in two nominations, prizes are not summarized.

The general prize fund is 20 000 US dollars.

9. Financing.

Payments for the prize fund and Arbiters, transfer, accommodation and board for invited participants and the Chief Arbiter of the tournament will be covered by UCF and tournament fees.

Travel expenses of participants and arbiters to the venue and back and per diems will be covered by sending organizations.
