## **1.0 Introduction**

17<sup>th</sup> AUUS Games-Association of Uganda University Sports is a national sporting and cultural festival which is staged every two years at a members home. The games got under way from the 16<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> of December 2017 at Ndejje main campus located within Luwero district. One of the goals of AUUS is to help member institutions develop their sports facilities and by what was seen at these games so far is very positive.

The 17<sup>th</sup> AUUS games were officially opened by Hon. Ephraim Kamutu on behalf of the president of Uganda His Excellence Gen. Y.K. Museven.

Among other sponsors for the games include Urban TV, DFCU, Xfm, AUUS .

## **2.0 Status report**

The 17<sup>th</sup> AUUS, games which took place at Ndejje University Campus main campus. Attracted a total of 17 Universities that participated over 10 disciplines of which chess was among.

The tournament attracted a field of 57 players with (24) ladies from 6 universities and (33) Men from 7 Universities.

MUBS Ladies women's team emerged winners in the 17<sup>th</sup> AUUS games in the ladies category and the Men's team came in second in their category

## **3.0 Rounds and System**

Round robin system was used for the AUUS games with time control of 1hr 20Min plus 30Sec/move for the ladies teams with a total of 10 rounds played and 1hr 30Min plus 30Sec/move for the Mens teams with a total of 7 rounds played.

## 6.0 Prizes and winners

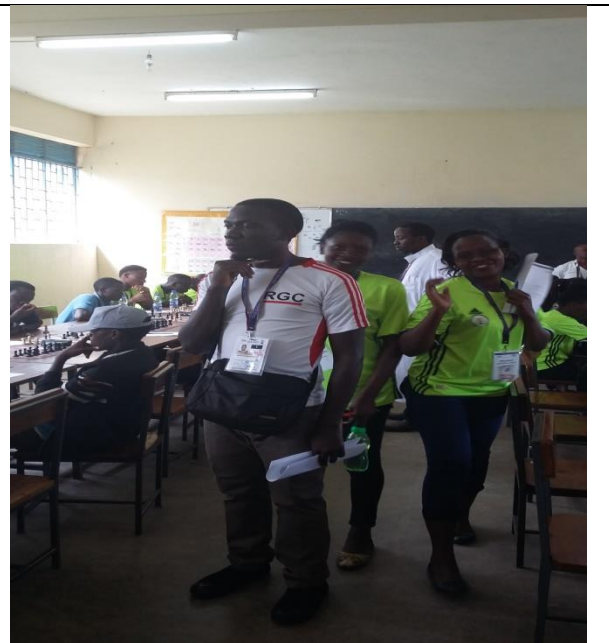
The top 3 Teams in both the Men's and ladies category were awarded prestigious trophies and certificates.

## 7.0 Challenges

- Players lack of knowledge of FIDE rules
- Few Teams form the Universities.
- Exam preparation, as players had to choose between playing the Games and preparing for their exams.
- Many rounds played in a short period with no breaks
- No supply to energy boosters and sugars for the team during the games
- Distance traveled from the playing area to the sleeping Village with limited security and means considering some games were played till late in the night.

## 8.0 Way forward

- MUBS Chess Club works more closely with UCF, NCS, ACC and FIDE to get the necessary assistance during national and international events to be able to meet top level performance
- MUBS Chess Club, prints and circulates rules and regulations in accordance to the National laws and FIDE rules to improve knowledge and understanding of them.
- Organizers must consider that toll the games have on players and have games played near the sports Village and also provide energy boosters during the games.
- Exam time table should be adjusted to allow teams be able to participate in these games.
