1. FIDE will approve (or disapprove) your proposed titles in the next FIDE PB meeting.
  2. An invoice will be send to your federation, according to your awarded title (FIDE Instructor = 100 euros \* National Instructor = 50 euros \* Developmental Instructor = 50 euros).
  3. After approval and payment the title certificates, pins and badges will be sent to your federations. If you do not receive any of the above by April, please contact [certificates@fide.com](mailto:certificates@fide.com).
  4. It would be advisable to pay directly your title fees by the end of January (see attached FTS-JED 2018-FIDE Payments). If you face any problems or need more advice, please contact [accounts@fide.com](mailto:accounts@fide.com).
  5. We have also sent you your Participation Diploma (all in one pdf file - FTS-JED 2018-Certificates), which you can print-out, by choosing your page.
- Please forward this letter to your federation officials, as they should be informed on your results.
- Once more we would like to thank you for your participation and for your efforts during the Jeddah (Saudi Arabia) FIDE Trainers' Seminar.
