1. FIDE will approve (or disapprove) your proposed titles in the next FIDE EB meeting.
2. An invoice will be send to your federation, according to your awarded title (FIDE Trainer = 200 euros * FIDE Instructor = 100 euros * National Instructor = 50 euros * Developmental Instructor = 50 euros).
3. After approval and payment the title certificates, pins and badges will be sent to your federations. If you do not receive any of the above by October, please contact certificates@fide.com.
4. It would be advisable to pay directly your title fees by the end of August (see attached FTS-GJO 2018-FIDE Payments). If you face any problems or need more advice, please contact accounts@fide.com.
5. We have also sent you your Participation Diploma (all in one pdf file - FTS-GJO 2018-Certificate), which you can print-out, by choosing your page.

Please forward this letter to your federation officials, as they should be informed on your results.

Once more we would like to thank you for your participation and for your efforts during the Gijon (Spain) FIDE Trainers' Seminar.
