
St Thomas of Aquin's High School

ADDITIONAL PRIZES:

Giant Killing, Best Game and Most Entertaining Game, £50 for each prize.

EDINBURGH EVENING NEWS CUP

This will be presented to the highest placed junior, in the Premier, under 18 on the 5 April 2019 normally resident in Scotland. A prize of £50 will also be awarded.

TIME CONTROLS

All Events: 90 minutes plus 30 seconds increment per move.
