7. **BID FEE** - Any bidder must pay a bid fee until the bidding deadline. Bid fee is not refundable. If the bid fee is not paid, the bid will not be considered valid.
8. **DEPOSIT FEE** - Within a month after being awarded FIDE Chess Championships, the organising member federation shall pay deposit fee according to General regulations of FIDE competitions. When the event has been successfully concluded (according to the bid and the regulations), the deposit fee shall be credited to the account of the organising federation or refunded.
9. EVE will make inspections. The first inspection will be within four months after the bid deadline. If the organizer is granted with the event, EVE will define the number and necessity of pre-tournament inspections. Single FB accommodation in one of the official hotel and domestic transfer costs of the inspections must be paid by the organisers.
